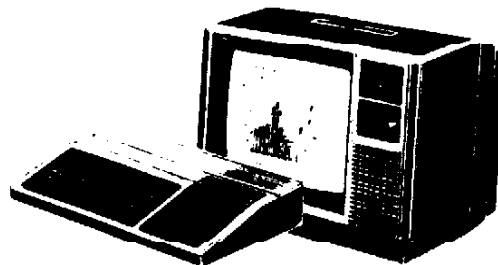


DALLAS TI HOME COMPUTER GROUP

RIGHT JUSTIFY NUMBERS

(CONTRIBUTED BY YOURS TRULY)

TIRED OF NUMBERS IN A COLUMN LINED UP BY THE FIRST DIGIT RATHER THAN THE LAST DIGIT OR THE DECIMAL? TRY THE FOLLOWING SUBROUTINE:

```
500 REM R.J.J. SUBROUTINE
510 IF POS(STR$(RJN))>"." THEN
540
520 PRINT TAB(T-LEN(STR$(RJN))) ;
STR$(RJN)
530 RETURN
540 PRINT TAB(T+1-POS(STR$(RJN)) ;
"." ; STR$(RJN)
550 RETURN
```

ANYTIME, IN THE BODY OF THE PROGRAM, YOU WISH TO PRINT A RIGHT-JUSTIFIED NUMBER (SPECIFIED OR CALCULATED),

LET RJN EQUAL THAT NUMBER, LET T EQUAL THE COLUMN TO CONTAIN THE DECIMAL, AND GOSUB 500. NOTE THAT THIS SUBROUTINE HANDLES INTEGERS, DECIMALS, ZERO, AND NEGATIVE NUMBERS.

EXAMPLE USAGE:
