- Remind Me! by John Johnson. Graphical calender with pop-up windows for daily entry of schedules and appointments. Quick searches and complete report printing control. Also interfaces with all clock cards as an option(not required). E/A, TIW, XB, or Myarc 9640.

Funnelweb v4.13 by Tony and Will McGovern. Complete operating environment with 40-column editor, formatter, custom loaders, C99, DiskPatch, and DM-1000. Custom configured and works in 80-column mode on Myarc 9640 or AVP-9938 board. XB, E/A, or Myarc 9640. (\$20.00)

Myarc HDECC Hard and floppy disk controller card for the TI-99/4A and Myarc 9640 computers. Fits in PEBox and controls up to 4 hard drives, 4 floppy drives, ramdisk, and streaming tape backup systems. Its data transfer rate is near the speed of ram. 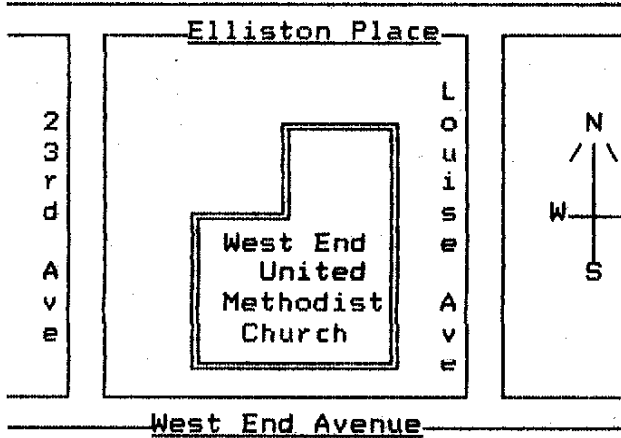

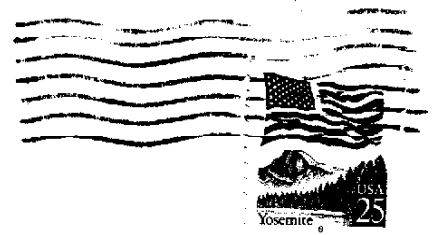
